The USDA, Rural Development, Business & Industry Loan Guarantee Program can provide loan guarantees for the purpose of:

- Acquiring new businesses or expanding existing businesses;
- Purchasing and improving real estate;
- Purchasing machinery & equipment;
- refinancing outstanding debt; and
- providing term working capital.

Projects prioritized by headquarters are those projects intended to further enhance the rural economies by providing well-paying employment, essential community services and long term investments. These priority projects include:

- Broadband; high-speed internet connectivity.
- Commercially available unmanned technologies.
- Food distribution such as grocery stores and food manufacturing along with agritourism and biotechnology.
- Advancement of energy security by boosting production of energy from natural gas, oil, coal and renewables.
- A focus on "made in America" including projects for infrastructure, distribution, and value-chain participants.
- Projects that advance the quality of life. For example modern utilities, medical services, and for the treatment and recovery of opioid addiction.
- Advancement of career training and development.

The loan guarantee can be used to provide better rates and terms to the businesses you serve while reducing lender risk. In addition to reducing risk, the issuance of the loan guarantee can allow for additional fee income through the sale of the guaranteed portion on the secondary market.

Should there be an opportunity to consider financing one of these projects, please keep these programs in mind. There are guarantees of 80% for loans up to \$5,000,000; 70% for loans of \$5,000,000 - \$10,000,000, and 60% on loans over \$10,000,000.

## Exciting New Projects in Our Region!

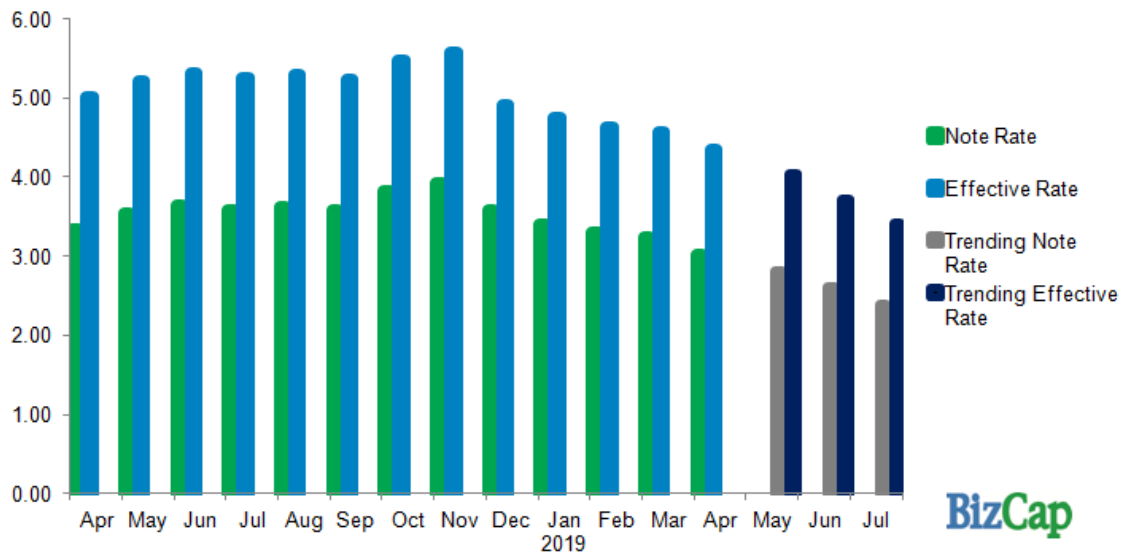
At our April Board meeting County Corp approved SBA 504 loans for All In One Tire & Auto Center in Tipp City and Unity Care Group in Centerville. This is All in One's second 504 loan through County Corp and was needed as they are growing faster than expected and they require a second building with additional service bays. Unity Care provides in-home health care services to individuals with developmental disabilities. This growing business is purchasing a building in Centerville where clients will also come to them for services.

County Corp recently funded a State 166 loan to Spradlin Bros. Welding in Springfield to fund the purchase of a new laser cutting machine. County Corp partnered with Security National Bank on this transaction. In addition, County Corp funded two CDBG (Community Development Block Grant) loans. One to Comfort Suites in Miamisburg for furniture and fixtures and the other to Ziehler Landscaping in Centerville for the purchase of an office condo for their sales and management team. No bank was involved in the Comfort Suites transaction, but we did partner with Farmer & Merchants Bank with the Ziehler loan.
